

## **NEW PLANNING CODE SUMMARY**

## **Entertainment Uses in South of Market**

Amended Sections: 249.39, 833, 836 & 840 Case Number: 2025-000444PCA Board File/Enactment #: 241208/069-25 *Initiated by:* **Supervisor Dorsey** June 8, 2025 Effective Date:

The Ordinance amended the Planning Code to eliminate the 200-foot buffer restriction in the Western SoMa Special Use District for Nighttime Entertainment uses located within 200 feet of a RED (Residential Enclave) or RED-MX (Residential Enclave-Mixed) District. It also principally permits General Entertainment and Nighttime Entertainment uses at 655 Folsom Street (Assessor's Parcel Block No. 3750, Lot No. 050), which is in the MUR (Mixed-Use Residential) District.
